And

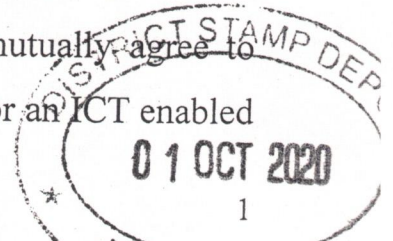

5. Responsibilities of the First Party


The First party shall:


Organise training and handholding activities for the Second Party in order to help implement the ICT enabled campus.

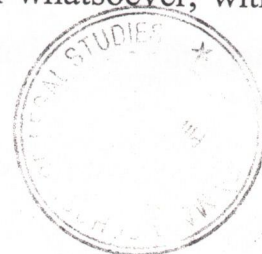
Ensure that collaboration is effective in terms of student and faculty exchange Programmes to be undertaken on mutually agreed dates

Ensure that collaboration is effective in terms of student and faculty exchange Programmes to be undertaken on mutually agreed dates

Provide assistance for conduct of study visits, consultations.


7. Force Majeure



10. Amendment to the Agreement

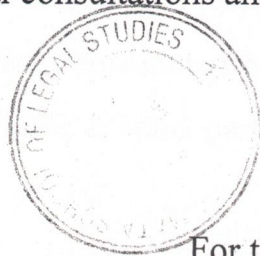

11. Period of Validity


This agreement shall be initially valid for one year from the date of signing the agreement and to be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both the parties.
