The Legal Aid Clinic of Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Choondy in association with Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat) conducted legal awareness classes on the Constitution of India in 18 wards of the Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat. The programme was a very well done by the legal aid students. The program was inaugurated by the Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat President Jijo V. Thomas at the K.A. George Library, Morakkala.

The focus of each 1.5-hour class was on the significance of the terms in the Preamble such as Justice, Equality, Liberty, Fraternity, Secular and Socialist and how these terms related to constitutional rights laid down in Part III & Part IV of the Constitution. 
