## **Report of Bharanagadana Janasadhassu held on February 2, 2019**

The Legal Aid Clinic of Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies, Choondy in association with Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat) conducted legal awareness classes on the Constitution of India in 18 wards of the Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat. The programme was a very well done by the legal aid students. The program was inaugurated by the Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayat President Jijo V. Thomas at the K.A. George Library, Morakkala.

The focus of each 1.5-hour class was on the significance of the terms in the Preamble such as Justice, Equality, Liberty, Fraternity, Secular and Socialist and how these terms related to constitutional rights laid down in Part III & Part IV of the Constitution. Each term was explained with the aid of real-life examples and posters. The audience consisted of residents of each ward, including men, women and children.

The classes created a discussion among the audience on their perceptions of the Constitution and their understanding of constitutional terms such as liberty and secularism. From BSOLS, a total of 100 students participated in this program. Three to four students were assigned to each ward. Representatives of the KSSP were also present in each ward so as to moderate the discussion on the Constitution.

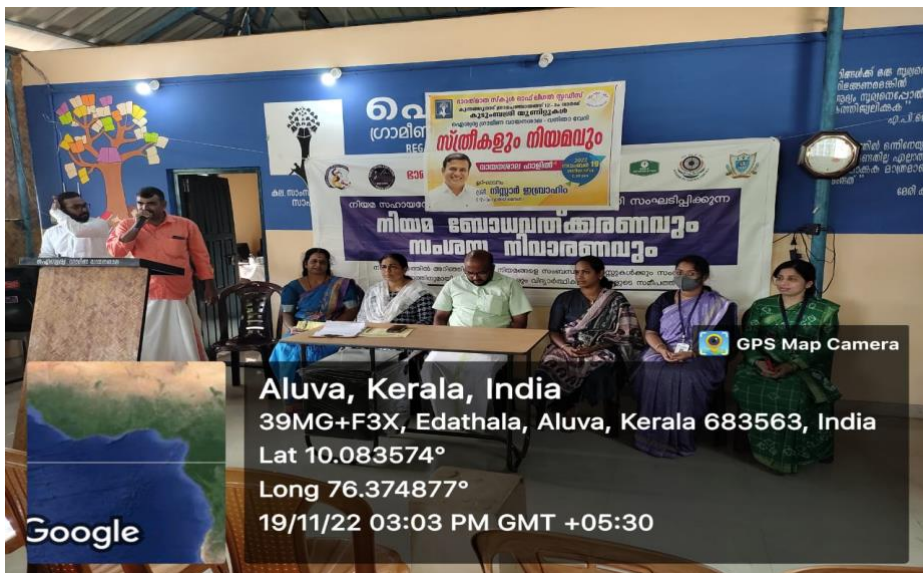

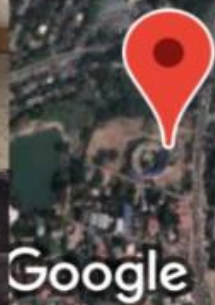

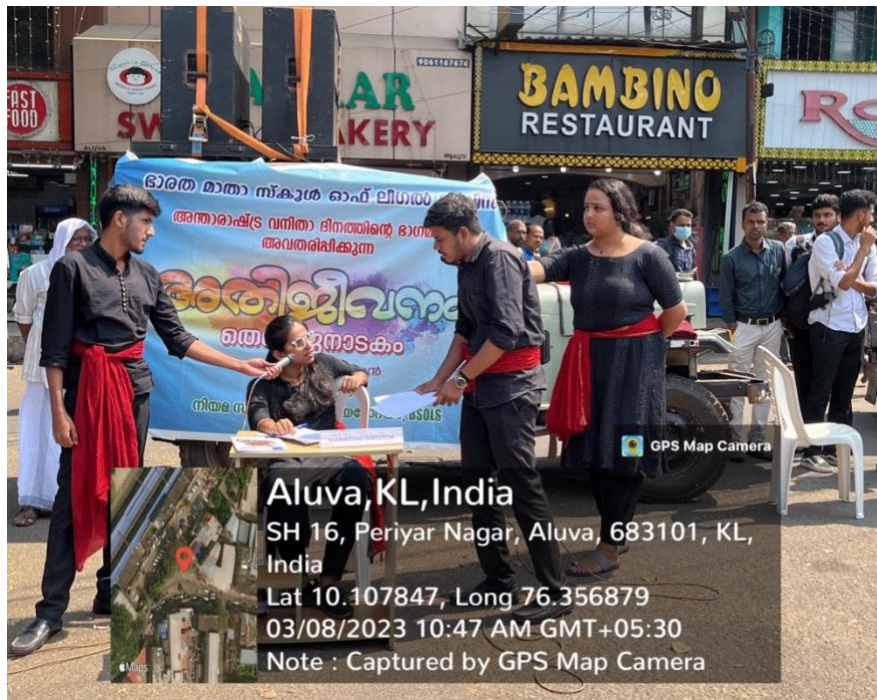
